

myriaCross editor - Lesson 14 : Embedding symbol fonts

Why embed symbol fonts ?



Some symbol fonts you use in your patterns may *not* be installed on all computers.

To ensure everybody will load your patterns and see the symbols you defined, fonts can be embedded in pattern files.

Saving to a *PCStitch* version 9 pattern :

Asks you if you wish to embed symbol fonts in pattern.

Saving to a *myriaCross editor* pattern :

Includes symbol fonts should you enable the option.

Some font files will never be embedded :

¹ These fonts are common to all versions of *Windows*

² These fonts are installed by *PCStitch*

³ These fonts are installed by *myriaCross editor*
