#### Why print your design?

In order to stitch your design, you will probably need to print it on paper. To be able to create a PDF document to share your creation, install a virtual PDF printer. Remember there is also a full screen display mode with fast zoom and pan using mouse wheel, automatic colour detecting when hovering other stitches and visual marking of desired grid square.

#### When print your design?


Assuming current pattern is not read only with printing disabled, you can print your creation when you want. Printout will use current grid, cross, backstitch, knot and bead styles. Should current pattern be read only, textured grid would display as grid lines in order not to hide the copyright watermark. Printout will also use settings in the print dialog. Warning: read only patterns with disabled saving to PDF document or picture creation will only allow printing to physical printers.

#### **High resolution printing**

Patterns are printed as pictures that are shared into sub pictures when they are too huge. This method ensures up to **3,600 dots per inch** printouts. As charms in a sub picture can lead to a huge picture too, they are internally shared into sub pictures; printing a pattern containing charms at a big zoom factor may take a while but it should *always* succeed.

#### Launching the print dialog

Either hit **Ctrl P** keys or select *File/Print* menu option.



First select desired **printer** in the list; next, set **paper size**, **margin size** around and **pattern scale**.

Warning: setting margins smaller than minimum margins for your printer can generate incorrect printouts; this is a setting you need adjust; in case of doubt, set margins to 1 inch.

To adjust minimum margins for your printer, set 0.25 inch margins, print something, increase margins and print again as far as you do not get an accurate printout. Should you want the program know minimum margins for your printer in the future, edit file *Margins.txt* you will find in *Installation folder\Tables* and add information for your printer:



Please send us this file so that next version of the program knows your printer.

Setting the **pattern scale** defines the count of pages but you can also increase this count to get more readable stitches.

Next, choose what to include in printouts:



You can include a **cover page** containing a preview of whole pattern chart with optional pages numbering and a text either below or at right of the preview; this text can be modified in the *pattern information* dialog.

Should you set more than one

page for the pattern, you can either print **all** pages, **specified** page or selected **row** or **column** of pages.

You can include **rulers** in stitches for cross stitch, knitting or latch hook patterns, in millimeters for embroidery or quilting motifs. You can include the **colour palette**, either at right of pattern chart, on a separate page or both.

You can include a list of used **buttons** and **charms**, either all, those having a provider, a reference or both.

You can include pattern **information** and **notes** on a separate page.

Should you enable the **mirror printing mode**, only pattern chart would be printed; you could only choose **accuracy** (exact size) over printout **aspect** (small size error but nicer rendering).



For knitting patterns with no more than 3 colours, you can also print **cards** 

for the **Passap E6000** knitting machine. Information about card to print displays at right.

Check Duplex option if you want to print to both paper sides and your printer supports this feature.












Normal printing mode
